The top having a option to tilt has a tulipwood crossbanded edge with a recessed apron which is supported by a beautifully shaped and curved pedestal base with curled feet and decorative central ormolu mounts. The center table is raised on original recessed brass castor having a tulipwood banded edge and is in excellent original condition having been lightly restored using traditional methods.
