## Antique Regency Sheffield Plate Chamberstick with Scissors & Snuffer c1820

## Description

This is an antique Regency Sheffield silver plated chamber stick dating from around 1820 with gadroon borders, and having its original snuffer. This beautiful chamber stick is particularly unusual as it has its original scissors, which are usually missing, plus it also has its original sconce. It is 4 1/2" (11.5 cms) tall and 6" (15 cms) across the base and is in excellent original condition. There are a few places where the silver has worn slightly and there is a hint of copper showing through, but this is not immediately evident. As you will know, Sheffield plate was first used in Sheffield England around 1770. It consisted of a sheet of silver each side of a piece of copper and from about 1790 decorative borders were often applied which were fashioned from lengths of silver wire. The process of electroplating came into fashion around 1840 from when Sheffield plating ceased to be used. Free worldwide fully insured shipping included in the price.
