Oil on canvas in a very fine Italian carved and giltwood frame. This excellent painting is a good example of the art of the Baroque period, with great care given to the depiction of the sitter's expensive silks and lace. Adriaen Hanneman (c. 1603 - buried 11 July 1671) was a Dutch Golden Age painter best-known today for his portraits of the exiled British royal court. His style was strongly influenced by his contemporary, Anthony van Dyck. He was born into a wealthy Catholic patrician family in the Hague, and studied drawing with Hague portrait artist Jan Antonisz. van Ravesteyn. SIZE: 43 x 37 inches inc. frame.
