The inkwell stands on four revolving wheels, enabling one to roll across the desk top, really for novelty value, so very popular during the Victorian era. Made from English silver plate, the cast basket of flowers is made from brass, creating a wonderful contrast to the silver. Being Elkington we are able to date the piece accurately with the number 8 punched inside the lozenge for the year 1848, a good early example of Elkington.
