An arched hood pediment surmounted by two original brass finials. Brass capped fluted hood columns and rear quarters. Fine fretwork panels to the hood side. A circular dial with date and seconds indicators. Blued steel hands. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. A quality feature often seen on London clocks of brass cased weights and a flat rod brass pendulum. Joseph Hatton of London is recorded in Bailies' Watchmakers and Clockmakers of The World' book as working from 1785-1830. Height 6ft 9 " / 205 cms.
