My silversmith was clever enough to find two period ladles which fit perfectly and finish the suite off perfectly. Again, the ladle bowls are gilded and each marked on the reverse for another remarkable silversmith, Mappin and Co. of Sheffield and London, the handles engraved with a regal Eagle Armorial Crest. Excellent condition dating to around 1880, late Victorian in era. Spanning 10" handle to handle and standing 5 1/4" tall to top of lid finial.
