The octagonal top veneered in the finest burr walnut with 8 "book matched" butterfly veneers and a moulded walnut edge with a pierced fretwork frieze with applied roundels and turned finials. The top is supported on spiral twist columns, upon a shaped platform base with turned bun feet and brass and porcelain castors. The design of this table is reminiscent of the English architect Richard Bridgens. this table could be used as either a dining table or a centre table.
