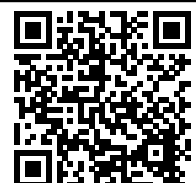
Description

A stylish antique 19th century mahogany side cabinet with serpentine front. With single top drawer over two quarter veneered oval panelled doors, angled fluted columns to edges, standing on cabriole feet to front and stile feet to back. It has a working lock and key to the main cupboard, and a single removeable shelf to the interior. European in origin, with Biedermeier influences, this is a really good quality stylish piece and a good size. It is showing signs of age – there is a split along the top which has been filled with wax (see photo) and some small veneer loss to bottom edges of both doors. Dating from the early to mid 19th century. Construction/Wood: Mahogany Condition Report: Showing its age – split along top which has ben filled with wax (see photo) and some small veneer loss to bottom edges of doors (see photo).
