The condition is excellent being fully restored and French Polished to our high standard, can be used with any combination of 1, 2, 3, or all 4 leaves or even without any leaves in place.

Underneath the table top is a very interesting paper label listing most of the towns this table has resided starting with Wakefield in 1863 to Leeds in 1898, it was removed recently from Leeds University. circa 1845 dimensions. length all leaves 352cms. no leaves, 143cms width, 140cms. height, 77cms
