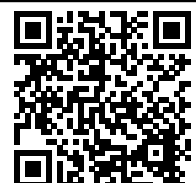
Here we see a chuval (large bedding-bag) made by Turkmen tribes in the middle Amu Darya area of Turkmenistan during the mid 19th century. The lovely aubergine field consists of 9 guls and an absolutely stunning main border pattern. The elem (lower skirt panel) is beautifully executed with stylised 'trees' and I love the filler motifs in the bottom left-hand corner - particularly the nicely drawn amulet - a symbol of protection. Size: 1.25m x 0.79m (4' 1" x 2' 7").
