The handle is made by exotic carved Mother of Pearl or Nacre shell with a bright shiny patina highlighting its iridescent qualities. The handle is joined to the sterling form with a highly decorative ferrule. The fork too is beautifully decorated, with a pierced or reticulated decoration finished with hand engraving. There is a full hallmark for Sheffield 1903, together with the makers initials for the silversmith, William Gallimore & Sons. Excellent condition, measuring 9 1/4" in length.
