The top with mahogany crossbanding and small quarter round thumb moulding to the edge. The drawers with cock beaded edges and very nice later rococo style brass swan neck handles. The brushing slide with matching cock beaded edge and ring handles. The whole piece displays the most gorgeous colour and patination, in fact it is so good I wish you could bottle it and use it on something else !!
