A superb quality 8 day Grandfather clock by YARNDLEY of BIRMINGHAM (1842). The flame mahogany case has inlaid boxwood and ebony stringing with rosewood crossbanding. It has a cathedral arched door, canted corners to the base, and stands on splayed bracket feet. The key lockable hood has a swan-neck pediment with brass patare and eagle ball finials. It has beautifully turned pillars to the sides which match those to the trunk of the case and both are surmounted with gilt brass Corinthian capitals. The clock retains its original French-polished finish and has a superb, rich patina. The painted arched dial has subsidiary date and seconds dials with a moon phase dial to the top. All are in perfect working order. The dial has a raised convex dish centre; a feature rarely seen and all in beautiful condition. The 8 day, bell striking movement has just been fully reconditioned in our own workshop by our own BHI registered staff.
