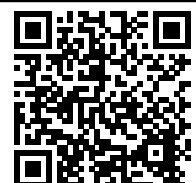
Description

A handsome pair of Victorian (circa 1860) pedestal chests - ideal as bedside cabinets, as extra storage in-conjunction with a similar period desk, or possibly placed either side of a sofa or/and to support a pair of lamps. Skillfully adapted from their original use as supports for a 19th century dressing table, these pedestals have been professionally restored and polished - all the locks now work with a similar period key supplied for each. The draw fronts & linings are constructed from mahogany, the bottoms of walnut, and apart from two turned replacements, the remainder of the knobs are original as are the escutcheons.
