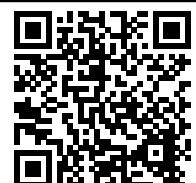

Brass stopped fluted hood columns and side glass hood apertures. An arched trunk door and re-entrant base panel to the slim, well proportioned case. An arched brass and silvered dial with date and seconds indicators. A 5-pillar, 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. Brass cased weights and a 'London' flat rod pendulum. Jeremy Martin of Tottenham (High Cross, London) is recorded in Loomes' 'Watchmakers and Clockmakers of The World' book as working in 1780 and a clock noted. Height 6ft 11 1/2" / 212 cms.
