An impressive mid-Victorian writing , or library, table. Very well made from solid English oak by the renowned makers of Maple and Co. of London. The mid-brown oak now has developed a nice colour and patina. The whole table is decorated with carved detailing, to all four sides so that it could be free standing within a room if required. To the front are a pair of drawers. The top is fitted with a sumptuous read leather writing surface, decorated with gilt tooling. The whole table stands well on twin barley twist columns , united by a further twin barley twist under-stretcher. This lovely table is offered for sale in excellent original condition, ready to go straight into the home. Dimensions: Width 105cms Depth 65cms Height 76cms Maple & Co was established by John Maple, a shopkeeper from Horley, Surrey, who later opened a furniture shop in Tottenham Court Road. However it was his son, John Blundell Maple , who made Maples & Co a success. With exceptional business skills, John B. Maple took over the company while still a young man. By the 1880s they were the largest furniture store in the world, exported their fine furniture to every continent. Maples manufactured t...

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
