The second drawer opens on superior quality brass hinging to reveal the writing desk complete with inset green baize surface, a series of six cubbies that are flanked by banks of triple drawers and beneath two further, each showing kingwood veneer and accessed with modest turned pulls. The chest's drawers are flanked by cylindrical columns terminating in later ball feet with the top displaying a good, aged patina, edged in flame mahogany and shaped to anchor the columns and frame the chest.
