The fourth drawer down opens to reveal a fine quality secretaire writing interior with a baize writing surface, pigeon holes and drawers. The drawers flanked by raised pilasters and having finely carved corbels, the right hand pilaster hinged and acting as the locking mechanism. The whole supported on a rosewood veneered plinth with rosewood veneered sides.
