The body is slice cut with hobnail decoration above. To the top rim and the foot is a band of silver. This item would have graced the finest Georgian table and is still usable today, some ideas being mayonnaise, cranberry, redcurrant, mint sauce or perhaps parmesan. The foot rim has a small area where a tiny piece of silver is missing (shown in photo), this does not appear to be damage, rather something on purpose and mentioned only for completeness. Date :- London 1809. Partial loss to maker's mark. Hallmarks :- Clear and readable. Height :- 10 cms. Diameter :- 8 cms. Base diameter :- 6.5 cms.
