The scroll ends with turned and wrythen-twist carved bars . The whole of finely-figured dense ebony . Constructed with traditional visible pegs , the frame with removable drop-in seat pad . Of larger than normal scale for this form of stool produced in ebony . Probably made in Galle district of Ceylon . The frame in excellent strong undamaged condition . W 22" H 11" D 14" Ceylon c. 1850
