Description

An antique silver Omega pocket watch originally retailed by Camerer Kuss & Co of London. The watch has a stem-winding movement which is working nicely. The serial number of 2,500,894 is underneath the dial, and this dates it back to around 1905. There is also a brevet, or patent, number 8760 which relates to an 1895 patent by the Brandt brothers, founders of Omega. The movement is protected by an inner hinged cover... it has some surface scratches, and a previous owner's name has been scratched into it. The watch measures 50mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The case is silver and there are Swiss hallmarks for 935 in both of the back covers, together with the early Omega mark inside the outer cover. Overall the case is in good condition with just an indentation to the bottom of the bezel. The engine turned detail is still nice and crisp. The watch glass has minor marks but is very acceptable. The signed white enamel looks to be in good condition to the naked eye but through a magnifying loupe, there are two faint hairline cracks visible. Camerer Cuss & Co was a partnership of David Kuss and Andrew Kammerer who came to London from Germany in 18...
