The lower cylinder bureau section also with a finely painted Vernis Martin panel depicting a romantic woodland scene and opening to reveal a sliding writing surface, pigeon holes and three mahogany lined brass inlaid drawers, with a further rectangular frieze drawer beneath. The whole supported on four turned and fluted brass inlaid legs with brass capitols and feet.
