A gents Tudor Royal wrist watch. 38 years after the first Rolex watches were made, Hans Wilsdorf (founder of Rolex) started a new sub-brand called Tudor, originating from his love of England and in particular the time of the Tudors. The watch has a signed hand-winding movement which is working well. The watch itself measures 34mm diameter excluding the winding crown and the lugs. The case is stainless steel and it is in very nice condition. The inside of the case back has the Tudor logo and the outside has the model number 1738. The winding crown has the Rolex logo. The lens is in good order. The signed dial is in its original finish and there is some pale freckling if you look closely. A new black leather strap has been fitted. PRICE INCLUDES WORLDWIDE POSTAGE
