A magnificent small antique William IV rosewood chiffonier sideboard dating from circa 1835. A good sized chiffonier at just under 3 feet. The top has an angular architectural pediment with shelf below supported by turned columns along with a rectangular mirrored back. Having cushion frieze drawer above 2 fielded arch panelled cupboard doors enclosing fixed single shelf, all standing on turned feet. In a beautifully figured rosewood, the door locks and come with working key. A stunning early 19th century piece in beautifully figured rosewood veneers with Gothic revival influences, it would make a beautiful side cabinet, TV unit, bookcase or hall cupboard. Construction/Wood: Rosewood Condition Report: Good patina to the rosewood. Appears to be the original mirror plate. General wear and marks commensurate with age.
