The dial, silvered with Roman numeral chapter ring, original heart-shaped hands, and dial engraved for "Hay, Davies St, Berkeley Square, London." The double fusee movement striking on a bell, with pull repeat, and the back plate likewise engraved for "Hay, Davies St, Berkeley Square." In good running order.
