AN EARLY GEORGIAN OAK CASED 'COTTAGE' LONGCASE CLOCK.C.1725.BRASS AND SILVERED DIAL WITH DATE APERTURE.ENGRAVED BIRDS TO THE MATTED CENTRE.30 HOUR BIRDCAGE MOVEMENT STRIKING ON A BELL TO THE HOUR.MOULDED CORNICE HOOD WITH TURNED PILLARS AND GILT MOUNTS.SIDE VIEW WINDOWS.MADE BY JAMES DELANCE OF DOWNTON,WILTSHIRE(W.1675-1736).FULLY OVERHAULED.STANDS 79"HIGH. *JAMES DELANCE WORKED IN FROME, SOMERSET FROM 1675 WHERE HE SUCCEEDED LAWRENCE DEBNAM.HE THEN MOVED TO LONDON 1678-85 AND REPORTS OF FRANCE THEREAFTER BEFORE RETURNING TO FROME.UNDER TAKING WORK ON CLOCKS FROM LORD WEYMOUTH OF LONGLEAT 1694-1703.BY 1721 HE HAD MOVED TO DOWNTON WHERE HE WORKED UNTIL 1736.HIS CLOCKS HAVE FENCH FEATURE WITH FINE PILLARS ALSO OF LONDON STANDARD WITH SOME FINE LANTERN CLOCKS MADE.
