A good early 18th Century oak coffer having two panels to the front, original hinges and attractive full length stiles. The interior has a candle box and is clean, it is lined with remnants of newspaper and a charming vintage wallpaper. The oak has a deep rich colour and patination that has been acquired over many years of polishing. There are some historic restorations as would be expected with a much used piece of furniture dating from the George I period.
