In superb original condition throughout. The drawers with all original lock and an original working key. . The fall with bookmatched pippin and burr walnut veneers and finely shaped lip and fitted with a hand coloured olive green thick hide leather to the shaped original recess. The fall lowers smoothly on original hinges to rest on two small extending oak lopers and reveals an exquisitely fitted interior dressed in pippin and burr walnut veneers. The small inner drawers with matching beautiful featherbanded borders, fully lined with slender oak boards and finely cut dovetailed joints. . With a deep well with original cover and with two concealed secret drawers flanking the cent...
