A good looking early 19th century mahogany WALL CLOCK in full working order. The mahogany case is original with its narrow moulded solid surround and slender box, whilst the wide concave-section bezel retains its original (working) lock and shallow convex glass. The 8-day gut-driven fusee movement has shaped plates and is absolutely original. The painted dial has been sympathetically restored and the slender blued steel hands are original.
