The base of the box, which unusually stands on four 'three-toed legs', has an embossed or repousse stunning floral, foliate scroll and trellis decoration running around its circumference. The top has a superbly pierced or reticulated design of a wedding scene with a coach and horses over a stunning decorative background of scrolls and pierced trelliswork and the interior of the box has a light gilt coating. The lid fits well and the 5 bar hinge are in very good condition. The box is in excellent condition with virtually no wear visible. This is a high quality, unusual and rare item made from good gauge silver and would make a superb addition to anyone's collection or a really special gift for someone.
