The chair was made in the reserved Georgian style but with subtle embellishments like the finely carved paterae on the arms. The straight square chamfered legs with cross stretchers make the chair sturdy but also classic in style. Each chair stands on brass castors A Gainsborough chair (also known as a Martha Washington chair in the USA) is a type of armchair made in England in the eighteenth century. The chair was wide, with a high back, open sides and short arms, and was normally upholstered in leather.
