Description

Large early C19th Regency period carved gilt-wood framed convex plate mirror. Finely carved gilt-wood frame with deep acanthus leaf carved scrolls to the top and carved berry pendant and leaf carving to the bottom, with carved spread-eagle pedimented surmount. The eagle with finely-carved feather detail perched upon a carved rocky outcrop, and the raised pedestal plinth with hatched /chequered decoration. The original grey silvered mercury convex mirror plate surrounded by an ebonised reeded slip. Deeply moulded cavetto-section circular frame with carved 'split-pearl' and spiral detail to the inner, with large closely spaced balls/spheres to the outer. The edge of the frame with triple moulded detail. In excellent original condition. Original gilded finish with only very minor historic repairs to losses of gesso and gilding.
