A good mid-18th century mahogany KNIFE or CUTLERY BOX in very fine original condition. Of usual form, the lid and serpentine front are both veneered in beautifully figured mahogany, with an ornate handle to the top; side handles and an orange brass clasp/escutcheon. The lid opens to reveal the original fitted interior in perfect condition; it is lined in original velvet and silver braid, as is the interior of the lid. 16ins high; 10ins wide; 12ins deep. (40 x 25 x 30cms) **This earlier form of interior fitting is more practical nowadays; later apertures cut into wood often will not accommodate certain cutlery items.
