This handsome Turkmen chuval (bedding bag-face), was made by Sariq tribes during the second half 19th century using cochineal-dye wool. Sadly, the original flatwoven back is long gone but nevertheless, the main focus must be on the knotted-pile face which depicts six powerful Saryk guls surrounded by minor 'teke-type' guls. The piece is in very good overall condition. Size: 1.60m x 82cm (5' 3" x 2' 8").
