A circular painted dial with 'regulator' dial layout of seconds, hour dial and single minute hand. A cylindrical compensating pendulum and brass weight. A well made mechanism of 8-day duration, dead-beat escapement and maintaining power. J H Allis of Bristol is documented in A J Moores' 'Clockmakers of Bristol' book as born in 1817 and worked until 1876. He made precision clocks and exhibited at the Great Exhibition in 1851.
