It bears clear makers marks for William Comyns and hallmarks for London 1902, which can be seen on the base of the silver top. CONDITION (see photos): In very good condition commensurate with age. No damage to the glass, just a few very superficial blemishes. The gilding is in good condition, the hallmarks are clear (the makers mark is a little rubbed but still perfectly legible).
