A rare George II silver Muffineer of squat baluster shape on a raised pedestal foot. This lovely piece has a pull off lid with reeded sides and the interior is fully gilded. These rare and collectable items are rather like small casters and were used for sprinkling a combination of powdered sugar and cinnamon onto muffins and other breads and cakes. A superb early example which features a handsome armorial. Around the collar are some charming original pricked initials.
