Intricately woven in weft-faced plain-weave with pattern wefts floating on the reverse, this bag is typical of the work done by the Zaggar Mengal nomads in Baluchistan. The goat-hair braiding with tassels attached, symbolically represent good luck. Woven circa 1900, bags of this age from this tribal group are now very scarce. Size: 45cm x 31cm (18" x 12") excluding tassels.
