This is an interesting piece. The silver mounted and pique tortoiseshell lid decorated with the SS Arcadian* flag. The plain circular silver base raised on four paw feet. The pull-off lid opens to reveal the original ivory silk interior. Black Morocco on the underside. *SS Arcadian was a Barrow-in-Furness built passenger liner constructed in 1899 by Vickers, Sons & Maxim Ltd for the Pacific Steam Navigation Company as SS Ortona. In World War I she served with the Royal Navy and was sunk by a U-boat in 1917. Hallmarks: LS&Co for Lionel Smith & Co. Birmingham Assay Mark. Lion Passant. Date letter "C" for 1927.
