(77.5 x 45.5cms) ***William Harris WEATHERHALL (1843-1903) was a London painter of genre, exhibiting at the RA from 1862 and in many other Societies. Interestingly, this specific painting is referred to in "Dictionary of Victorian Painters" by Christopher Wood, page 503.
