Herring, Sr., who was patronized by the English aristocracy for his famous Sporting and Equestrian paintings. Due to Herring, Sr.'s popularity among the nobles, Herring, Jr. was exposed to fine painting and wealthy patrons early on in his career. Herring, Sr. felt threatened by his son's ability and growing popularity, incorporated 'SR' at the end of his signature in order to differentiate their works after 1836. Although Herring, Jr. assisted his father, he was keen to ma...
