Description

This is a superb and very unusual shaped Victorian hallmarked solid sterling silver mustard pot complete with liner measuring 3" (8 cms) high x 3 3/4" (9.5 cms) across including the handle x 2 3/4" (7 cms) deep. It's hallmarked for London 1847 with the silversmiths mark for Joseph Angell I and Joseph Angell II and comes with a spoon hallmarked for Sheffield 1923 which was obviously added at a later date. The spoon and pot without the liner weigh 151 grams and everything is in excellent condition. The most unusual feature is the decoration of this mustard which is quite unique - all around the edge is engraved decoration of an Egyptian scene which we think is of the temple of Isis at Philae complete with palm trees and desert.
