Beautiful French carved alabaster sculpture of a female, signed in the alabaster by the Belique artist Gustave Van Vaerenbergh. This sculpture is in very good condition with fine carving. This sculpture is set on a shaped Fior di pesco Apuano marble base. GUSTAVE VAN VAERENBERGH (1873- 1927) He was born in Ghent on January 6th 1873 and died in Scharbeck on the 16th February 1927. He studied at the Academy of Fine Arts in Ghent from 1888-1890. He was a sculptor who specialised in the art of sculpting female busts. Working in various materials primarily in marble, alabaster, bronze and terracotta. His workshop in Ghent came under the name (Carli and Fre'res). He was highly regarded by his fellow artists for his skill and his attention to detail, creating many wonderful sculptures.
