Description

Possibly the Rarest Omega Seamaster ever made. Reference model OJ2657 Movement cal 342 Serial number 12852375 Date of production March 1953. Oversize case diameter 37mm without crown. Deluxe solid 18ct gold dial, unmarked and perfect. All original and untouched with original glass, strap and box. The movement has just been overhauled by the official Omega level 3 repairer Robert Reeves MBHI, only the glass was replaced, the old glass was retained along with the original black strap. The strap fitted is a new genuine Omega replacement and the Omega buckle is solid 9ct gold, a later addition with a Birmingham hallmark for 1964. The watch is in outstanding original untouched condition with only the slightest of scratches to the original glass, the case has never been polished and all edges are factory fresh. The Omega Museum does not appear to have an example of this model reference and it is not listed in their online Heritage Vintage Watches database, they also cannot or will not tell me how many were produced. This model is not listed in any Omega reference book including Omega a Journey Through Time which is normally thought to cover every model ever produced...
