Description

A really clean and tidy Mahogany Serpentine fronted Bachelor chest with excellent graining in a Chippendale style. This lovely chest has the original brass handles and is in great condition both inside and outside. The flame mahogany graining is set off by the wide cross banding all around the top surface. The drawer fronts which sit under the brushing slide are also boasting excellent graining and down the styles there is blind fretwork which its self sits over neat little cabriole legs. This chest is a really super size at 33ins wide but has good storage space in the four drawers. A great item which can fit anywhere in the house, it carries the plaque of cabinet makers Thomas Clarkson.

Thomas Clarkson & Sons have been in existence since the 17th century. The Clarkson family were first recorded as clockmakers in London in 1640. In 1755, Hewitt Clarkson moved the business to Cock Street, Wolverhampton, Staffordshire. The family continued to trade there successfully, manufacturing long-case clocks. In about 1780, the business moved to Dudley St...
