An Oak Arts & Crafts Period Scottish School wardrobe. The plain stepped moulded cornice above the twin breakfront central doors with stylised pewter panels with Arts and Crafts Roundels below and ripple moulding. The doors have typical Arts & Crafts heart shaped handles and open to reveal a brass hanging rail. Each end of the wardrobe having a Charles Rennie Mackintosh inspired leaded glass panel and enclosing shelved interiors, again with ripple moulding. Supported on an oak stepped plinth, possibly Scottish circa 1900-1910. Dimensions: 86" wide x 78" high x 23" deep centre (19" deep at the ends).
