A really unusual late Victorian silver plated dish formed by two hands cupped together. I am not sure if this dish was for a particular use, such as for visiting cards. The handle is of naturalistic form with grapevine decoration. The underside of each hand is struck with the retailer's mark (Pearce of Leeds and Huddersfield). The silversmith's makers mark is also present for the well renowned Sheffield maker of William Padley. Excellent condition, measuring 8" x 5 1/2" x 4" tall to top of handle.
