Description

A gent WW2 era military style Lanco wrist watch. Langendorf was a well respected Swiss watch making company and they traded for exactly 100 years from 1873. They used several brand names including Lanco, Larex and Lancyl. The watch has an in-house hand-winding movement, calibre 1214, which is working nicely. The movement is fully signed. The watch itself measures 34.5mm diameter excluding the winding crown and the lugs. The military style case is plated with a stainless steel case back. There is some marking to the case in line with its age but overall the condition is very acceptable for such an early piece. The lens is in good condition. The signed dial has a couple of small patches of light marking but they are not too noticeable to the naked eye. Blued steel hands, dark red centre seconds and outer minute markers. A new leather strap has been fitted. The watch will be sent in a new presentation box. PRICE INCLUDES WORLDWIDE POSTAGE
