Tall oak case, the hood featuring a broken pediment and turned pillars, over a long slim door with shaped top. Eight day works featuring the Owen's trademark five pillar movement and striking the hours on a bell. Highly decorative engraved brass dial with pierced spandrels and a separate silvered chapter ring, second dial and date display.
