Raised on a shaped concave-sided tri-part platform base with turned feet below. The centre column support with moulded ring base below carved bands of 'stiff-leaf' detail. The single-piece top with a shallow frieze edge with moulded detail. The whole of wonderful rich golden colour and patina, in excellent original condition. Complete with original cast brass bolts enabling the table to be tipped. The underframe of the table fitted with wooden sliding release. The column removable from the base with a peg beneath the platform. Stunning decorative centre or breakfast table with an exotic colonial attraction.
